Paul graduated from Northeastern University and served as the Executive Director of Charles River Industries, a sheltered workshop for mentally and physically handicapped children and adults located in Needham, Mass. In his “other career,” Paul served as the New England / USA scout for the Buffalo Sabres for 30+ years and a summer league coach to a generation of players in the greater Boston area.

Paul was a friend, mentor, and coach to many in both his careers and part of the “golden age” of hockey guys in New England, full of love and respect for each other and everyone associated with the game. HOCKEY INFO

- Game updates via Twitter and Instagram @OverSpeedHockey and at overspeedhockey.com.
- All teams are guaranteed 4 games with placement and championship games at all levels.

- Games will consist of three 17-minute periods, flood after 2nd. Warm-ups will be five minutes and lead immediately into the start of the game. All teams must be ready for warm-ups five minutes prior to the scheduled start of the game. If a team is not ready to play, this will result in a minor penalty to start the game.
- If regulation time expires and the game is tied, sudden death OT will be played 3 vs. 3 for five minutes running time. There will be no shootout in round robin games. Championship Games will be played with a 10 minute 3 vs. 3 OT, followed by a shootout.
- Point system will be based on 3 points maximum per game if won in regulation. A game ending in a tie at the end of regulation will result in each team being awarded a point. If a game is decided in OT, the winning team will gain an extra point.
- Championship seeding will be based on total game points earned through the three round robin games. Tie-breakers will be as follows: head-to-head, goal differential, period points (1 point per period won, not leading), coin flip.
- Playoffs will place 1st vs. 2nd, 3rd vs 4th at the U14 and U15 levels. At the U16 and U18 levels, playoffs will feature 1st vs. 2nd, 3rd vs. 4th, and 5th vs. 6th.
- Home teams are listed on the schedule — the highest seeds will be home teams for games on Sunday. Home teams will wear light uniforms.
- USA Hockey rules will be played.
